The ATS is supporting educators and investigators who are redefining how pulmonary, critical care, and sleep medicine are taught and learned. Through two innovative grant programs, faculty and medical educators can secure funding to design, implement, and evaluate creative educational approaches that drive meaningful impact across institutions and training programs:

Medical Education Research Grant (\$10,000), sponsored by the Section on Medical Education (SoME).

ATS-APCCMPD Research Grant for Medical Education of the Physician-Scientist (\$10,000), sponsored by the ATS and the Association of Pulmonary and Critical Care Medical Program Directors (APCCMPD).
