Target Audience:

Early-career investigators interested in Alpha-1 Antitrypsin Deficiency research.

The objective of this grant is to provide support for early-career investigators who are starting their research careers and intend to pursue a career in Alpha-1 Antitrypsin Deficiency research. Applications will be accepted from candidates holding an M.D., Ph.D., or equivalent degree who are interested in conducting basic science, clinical research, or ethic, legal, or social issues studies related to AAT Deficiency.

Applicants must indicate a commitment to AAT-related research by focusing 50% of their time on AAT Deficiency research or clinical practice.

Indirect costs will not be paid to the sponsoring institution.
