



ALA/ATS/CHEST Respiratory Health Equity Research Award

One grant available for 2027

\$100,000 per year for two years

Target Audience:

This funding opportunity is available to early-career investigators that are authorized to work in the United States for the duration of the grant (Jan. 1, 2027-Dec. 31, 2028). Applicants that are not U.S. citizens or permanent residents must hold a valid U.S. work visa that covers the grant period.

The ALA/ATS/CHEST Respiratory Health Equity Research Award supports early-career investigators conducting clinical research to improve the prevention and treatment of lung diseases that disproportionately affect underrepresented populations in the U.S and globally, with the goal of addressing health equity in respiratory care.

Applicants may request up to \$100,000 per year for up to two years for salaries, supplies, or a combination of thereof. A maximum of one award will be funded in this grant cycle.

Indirect costs are not supported.
